How does a crisis work?

Before the conference

- ▶ **The actual crises will only be revealed at the conference itself, so preparations on the issues are somewhat complicated**
- ▶ **Crises can take on a number of different topics, therefore it is expected that one not specializes on a particular attribute of a country, but has a general knowledge of its history, economy, military, ideology, geopolitical standing, government and geography**
- ▶ **Though you may be appointed a certain country, remember that a crisis can change everything you know about that country, be ready for certain dynamic changes**

At the conference

- ▶ **Stay in character**

A crisis only works if all delegates stay in character and represent their countries as they should be. No warmongering without a casus belli

- ▶ **Be ready to speech at any moment**

The crisis council can call upon any delegate to give a speech at any moment, therefor you must always be ready

- ▶ **Be dynamic**

Crises can have strange effects on countries, you might not have the same government or opinion during the entire conference, therefor you must stay dynamic and always be ready, even during unexpected setbacks

The Crisis

- ▶ **Opening presentation**

The Chair gives an opening speech about the crisis and what it entails

- ▶ **Set-up**

Delegates receive a small package with information detailing the upcoming crisis and their potential involvement

- ▶ **Opening speech**

One or multiple delegates need to give an opening speech to further the development of the crisis

- ▶ **Railroaded crisis**

The chair will present a series of events on which delegates have to speak

- ▶ **Lobbying**

Delegates can now lobby on how they would solve this particular issue

- ▶ **Open crisis**

Delegates are now allowed to dynamically debate the issue and present amendments to the resolution (Ad Hoc)
